He loved being out of doors, and took pride in his yard, flower gardens and garden. He cared for his wife, Edith, in their home for many years until her declining health was too demanding and she was placed in a Nursing Home.

Edith, Hugh's wife; took pride in their home, and was a wonderful housekeeper. She too, liked to garden, and took pride in her beautiful flowers. He was head of the Safety Proceedures Group, where he compiled and wrote the Safety Manuel for the safety proceedures for the Space Shuttle launchings, which included the Appollo Program (Man's First Walk on the Moon) and the Shuttle programs. He was very intellegent and loved very detailed work, such as this safety manuel.

Hugh loved automobiles and loved to "tinker" on his Triumph Sports Car, which was his "pride and joy". He loved to read and especially about history, and he had many books on history, especially the Civil War history. He had a wonderful sense of humor and could supervise his employees well. He always smoked a pipe, having several and in different designs.

Christine Marie Compton 8, daughter of Hugh and Dorothy Compton, married Henry Felix Trombley on 23 December 1978, but this marriage was dissolved on 24 July, 1979.
